- **B.** Each team's score will be calculated from all juries' score average for each team.
- **C.** Experts from relevant areas to the presentation subjects be recruited as jury panels.
- **D.** When the score is a tie among more than two teams, the team who has gained higher scores from higher weighted criteria category will win.
